Abraham Brothers – George and Ashley (work 1890-1920) - climbers and photographers who lived in Keswick. They made a photographic record of the exploits of many of the climbing pioneers of rock climbing.

Ansel Adams (1902-1984) - an American landscape photographer and environmentalist known for his black-and-white images of the American West. http://anseladams.com

Bill Brandt - In the late 1930s, working as a photojournalist Brandt began to photograph the industrial cities and coal-mining districts of northern England, creating images that reveal the desperation of England's industrial workers during the 1930s. During WWII he captured home-front scenes. He later did nudes.... http://www.billbrandt.com/

Henri Cartier Bresson (1908-2004) - a French humanist photographer considered a master of candid photography. He pioneered the genre of street photography, and viewed photography as capturing a decisive moment.
